## VINEYARD

Creation : XIX<sup>th</sup> century

<u>Area</u>: 30 hectares (one single block), 21 of vines

<u>Type of soils</u> : Clay with areas of silica gravel and iron pan

Grape varieties :

- Merlot	70%
- Cabernet Franc	15%
- Cabernet Sauvignon	15%

Average age of vines : 35 years old

## VINIFICATION

<u>Type of vats</u> : 50% stainless-steel and 50% concrete, all temperature controlled

<u>Ageing</u> : 16 to 18 months, one third in French oak barrels (50% of new) and two thirds in vats.

Average production : 140 000 bottles

Tasting note :

Round, juicy and appealing, Château Bel-Air is both a very well-balanced and profound wine that expresses the sophistication and the finesse of its terroir. Powerful, rich and dense, it also has a great ageing potential.
